

Mary, Servant of Love



One of the titles of Our Lady is Mother of Beautiful Love. Is not the Virgin Mary the greatest servant of the Love of God?

In this month of June, we celebrate the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In 1675, in Paray-le-Monial, France, Jesus, showing his Sacred Heart to Saint Marguerite-Marie Alacoque while she was praying before the Blessed Sacrament, said to her: "Behold this Heart which has loved men so

much that it spared nothing until it exhausted itself and consumed itself to show them its love..."

The generosity that springs from the Heart of the one who is All Love is infinite. It is at the very heart of Christian Revelation: we believe in one God who has made himself close to us and to all that concerns us, in a love which is given to us "absolutely free of charge, without any prior merit", even more, "a love that forgives." (Benedict XVI, *Deus Caritas est*, 9)

The great ideal of Christian life is to experience God's love within us which consists of being able to love the person whom I do not know or whom I do not appreciate. If I have no relationship with God, I cannot recognize the divine image in this person.

Our Rosary Team is the right place to learn to see the other differently with a look of love that goes beyond our human gaze. Let us ask Mary, Servant of Love, to allow us to look at each other with the eyes of Christ.
